- Follow Housing First practices, and have low barriers to entry.
- Target System Improvement, Racial Equity, Housing Opportunities and/or Advocacy.
- Comply with or are working toward complying with the <u>RTFH Community Standards</u>.
- Are located in or serve the San Diego Region (headquarters can be outside the region)

Litmus Test:

- O Does your program advance the system?
- o Is it an innovation that can be replicated and scaled?
- Does it need to be supported by ongoing private dollars or can you transition into eligibility for government funds?
- [new non-profit? Why need to start new org? why not work with existing providers? H4H
 are you working with serving seniors?]
