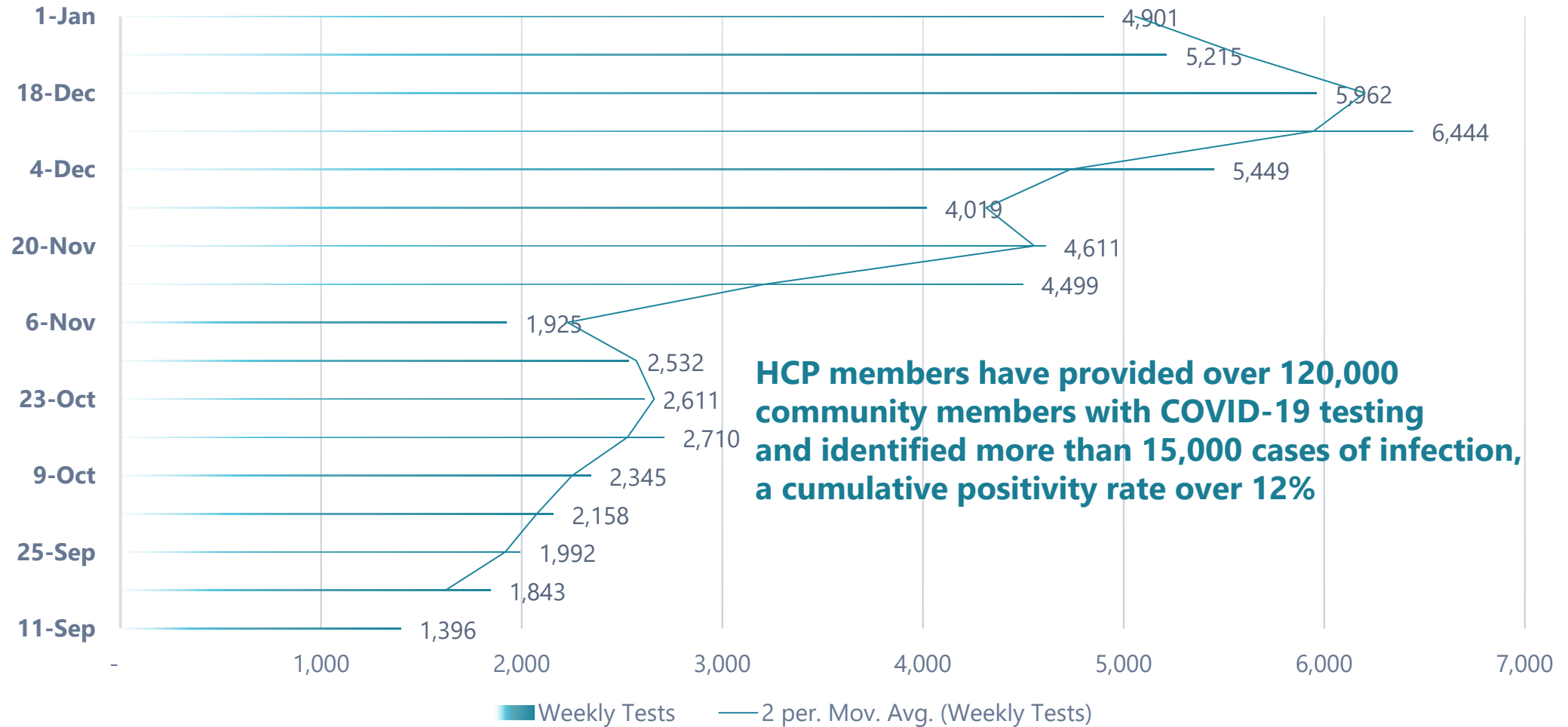

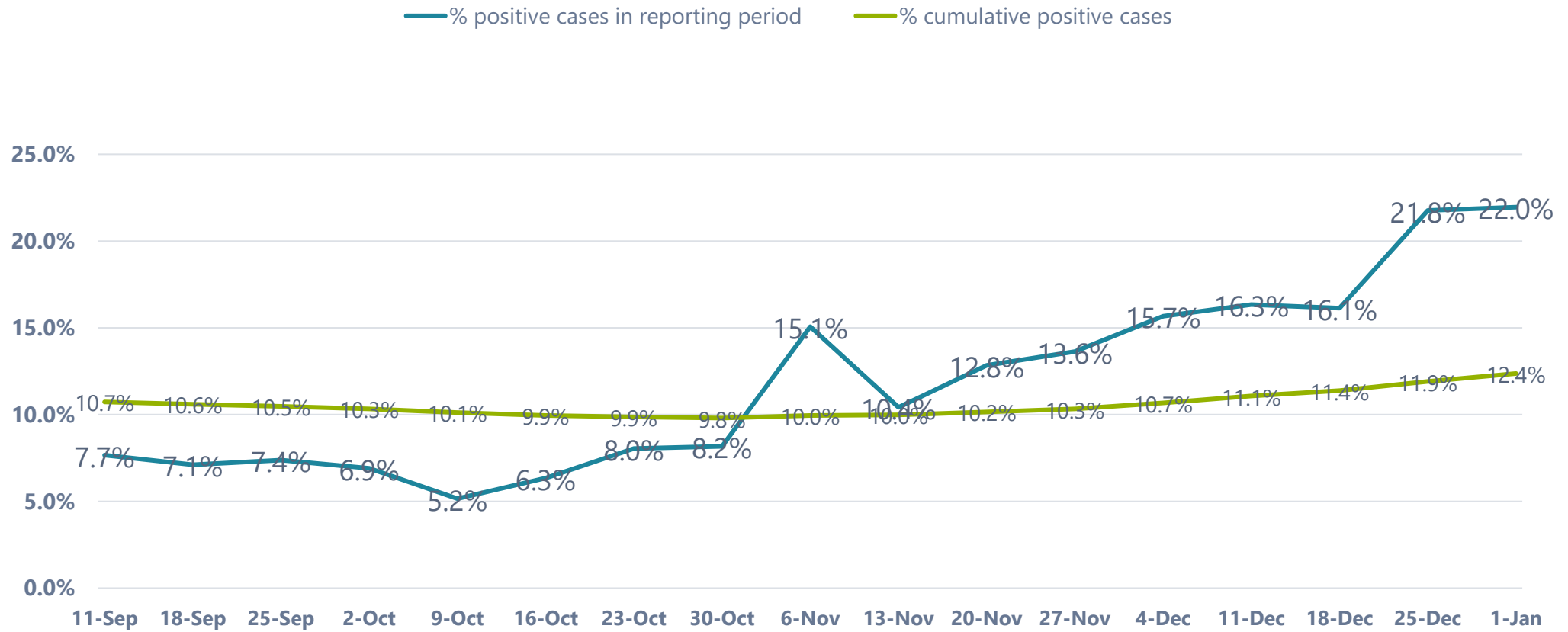

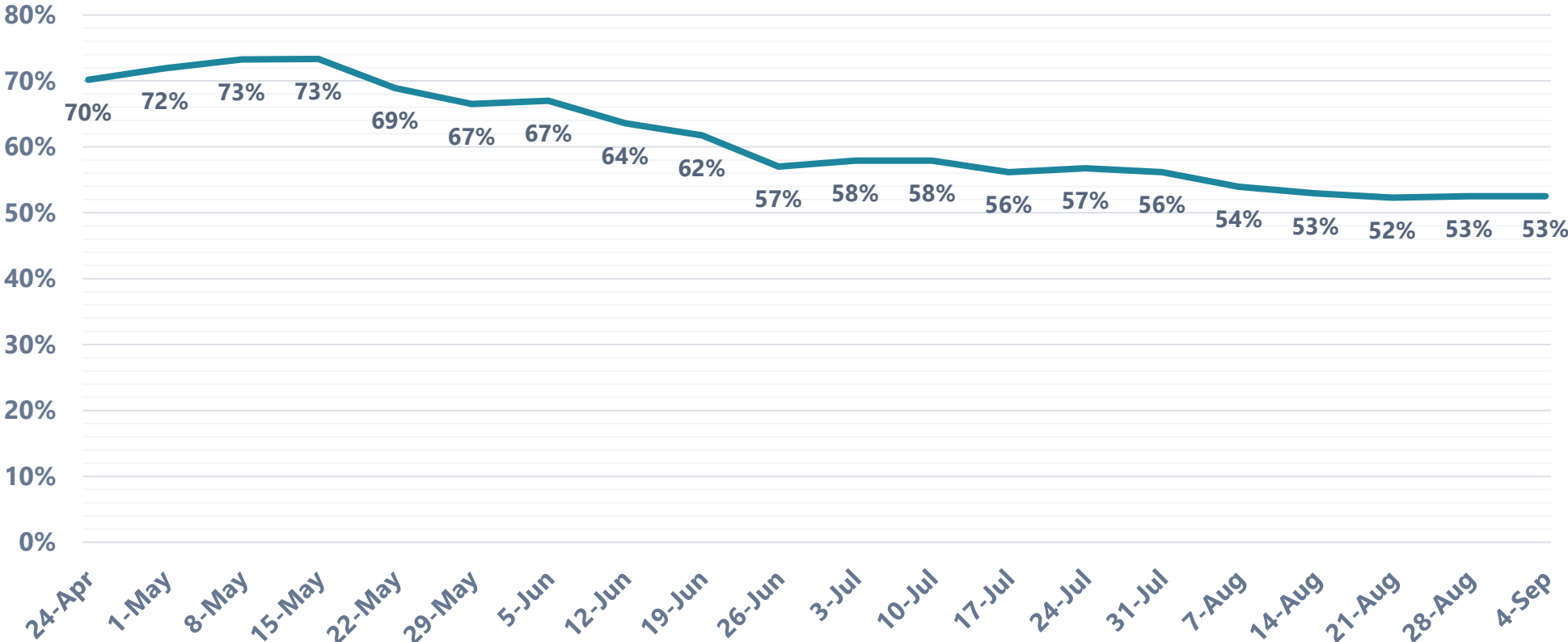
COVID-19 Diagnostic Testing at HCP Health Centers

Discussion : COVID-19 Vaccine Engagement & Collaboration

HCP partnered with the Community Clinic Association of Los Angeles County, the Coalition of Orange County Community Health Centers and the Community Health Association Inland Southern Region to provide its members with **resources, training, communication strategies, peer-to-peer learning opportunities, and technical assistance** to encourage participation of staff, patients, and community members in Census 2020.
